I'm a maverick working at the intersection of science communication research, practice and teaching in India. I graduated with a Bachelor of Science (Research) in Biology from the Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore and then a Master's in Science Communication & Public Engagement from the University of Edinburgh, UK.

I currently work as the Communications & Program Coordinator for NCBS Bangalore, and in 2019, founded the SciCommSci Club as a flagship initiative for engaging with the science of science communication and promoting evidence-based science engagement practices. Over the last 7 years, I have accumulated a rich diversity of work experiences in India and the UK, including working as a Content Editor for Research Matters (Gubbi Labs) in India, and as a Science Communicator for organisations like Edinburgh International Science Festival, Pint of Science, Proteus, and EuroStemCell in the UK.

My academic interests focus on understanding the intersectional challenges of engaging Indian publics with science, exploring the research-practice-teaching continuum within science communication, and developing community-centric science engagement practices for the Global South. I also spend a lot of time advocating for more inclusive, decolonised and multicultural forms of science engagement, contributing to training, mentorship and capacity-building efforts, as well as building policy, infrastructure and communities of practice around science-society interfaces in India.
